The Public Management Research Association (PMRA) is now accepting applications for **five open positions** on the PMRA Board of Directors. Serving on the Board is a rewarding opportunity to contribute to the advancement of public management research and help shape the future of our organization.

#### About the Role

Board members serve a four-year term, beginning at the close of the PMRA summer conference in June 2025 and concluding in June 2029.

Responsibilities include:

- Attending quarterly Board meetings (one held during the PMRA summer conference).
- Serving on committees and supporting PMRA initiatives.
- Contributing to the strategic planning and implementation of PMRA's mission.

We are seeking applications to develop a slate of **8–10 qualified candidates** for these positions. Applicants must be current PMRA members, with preference given to faculty with an established research record and active involvement in PMRA.

#### How to Apply

To be considered, please submit:

- A brief biography (250 words max).
- A statement of interest (250 words max).
- A description of past involvement in PMRA (250 words max).
- A link to your professional website and CV.

#### Deadline to Apply: January 15, 2025

Applications will be reviewed by the Nominating Committee, with the following timeline:

1. **January 15–31, 2025:** Applications reviewed and slate finalized.
2. **Early February 2025:** Board voting on the proposed slate.
3. **Late February 2025:** Membership voting on selected candidates.
4. **Early March 2025:** Selected candidates notified individually.
